Renault showcases concept hybrid

New Delhi, February 3

Renault showcased its concept hybrid Eolab, which is claimed to deliver 100 km to a litre of petrol. Patrick Lecharpy, Director, Design Synergies for the group, who is also in charge of Renault's design centres in Chennai and Mumbai, believes the hybrid could be on the roads in 2022. "This is a real vehicle study that was started after the French state initiated a project to study less than 2-litre engine," he explained. Among the innovations in the Eolab are a carbon floor, a magnesium roof and a smaller three-cylinder engine. All this shaves off 30 per cent of the weight of an equivalent car, the company said.
