RENAULT India on Tuesday unveiled a new version of Fluence, its premium sedan in the Indian market. The new Renault Fluence, with all new styling and a range of fresh features and a high performance engine, has been priced at Rs 13.99 lakh (ex-showroom Delhi).

The new Fluence model features a sporty and progressive design in line with Renault's new brand identity. It has got an efficient dCi engine and has new entertainment features and driver-aid facilities, a statement from the company said.
